Introduction

Ngati Ranginui Iwi members are invited to apply for an Education Grant to assist with their 2021 tertiary course fees. Applicants must:

- Ensure they are registered, or the applicant's parent/s registered, on Ngati Ranginui Fisheries Trust Beneficiaries Register and must provide registration number (enrolment forms can be obtained from the Iwi's office).
- Be undertaking study at a recognised Tertiary Institution (e.g. Polytechnic, University and Whare Wānanga) in New Zealand.
- Provide verification of all course costs.
- Return the completed Application Form to the Iwi office by the due date (prior to 4pm, Friday 19th March 2021).
- Sign applications in pen and not in electronic form.
- **Incomplete and late applications will not be considered and will be declined.**

First preference will be given to applicants who can demonstrate that:

- They actively participate in Ngati Ranginui Iwi, Hapu and/or Marae activities;
- Their course of study will contribute to the future development of Ngati Ranginui Iwi, Hapu and/or Marae.

The Ngati Ranginui Fisheries Trust Education Grants Committee will consider all applications. The Committee's decision is full and final, and no appeal process shall be entered into.

The successful applicant's grant will be paid directly to the applicant unless agreed otherwise.
